Board members and the audience were asked for questions and comments on the budget. President Lohmann noted a new line item in the budget: Parks, which he noted, takes money away from other departments this year. Kim Koutsky asked if the MGM lawsuit impacted the budget.

When there was no further discussion, President Lohmann asked for a motion to close the public hearing. Trustee Szymanski made a motion to close the hearing at 7:15 p.m.. Trustee Ahrendt seconded the motion.
