On 5-5-24, Diego Garcia, 32 of Chicago was arrested for leaving the scene of an accident, failure to reduce speed to avoid an accident, possession of adult use cannabis in a motor vehicle, driving while license suspended and DUI. After being processed he was released on a notice to appear.
