On 6-1-24, Stephen Henry, 32, of Chicago, Sharrod Wilson, 31, of Chicago and Byran Caldwell, 30 of Chicago were arrested by Beecher and Grant Park police and charged with forgery for incidents that occurred at Beecher and Grant Park businesses on 6-1-24. They were released on a notice to appear.

On 6-10-24, Carlos Ruiz-Cortes, 26, of Joliet was stopped and issued citations for having a suspended registration, invalid temporary visitors drivers license, speeding and no insurance. He was released on a notice to appear.
